

DAY 1

You will arrive to Prague, after transfer to your hotel enjoy your free time. Overnight in Prague – 4*hotel.

DAY 2

Visit the vibrant city of Prague, the Czech cultural crossroads, exploring the city on a hike to the old town square „Staromestske namesti“ where the Czechs celebrate all the important events and „czech out“ the Astronomical clock just behind the corner, visit the Jewish corner of this city, famous Charles Bridge, national theatre and many other great places in the city. Later on we will visit the oldest pub in Prague „U Fleku“ which was established just after America was discovered in 1499 and decide for yourself whether Prague truly is the home of Europe’s finest beers. Overnight in Prague – 4*hotel.



DAY 3

We will start this day with a decent tour of the famous Prague castle with St. George’s Basilica, and St. Vitus Cathedral! After the tour of the castle, we will transfer to one of the nicest towns in Czech republic and also the UNESCO heritage place – Cesky Krumlov. Overnight in a hotel in the historical part of this unique town.



DAY 4

We will spend the whole day in this beautiful town, walking in through narrow streets and visit the Castle above this unique historical town. Overnight in a hotel in the historical town centre.



DAY 5

After breakfast we will transfer to another historical town in South Bohemian region – Trebon which was established around the middle of the 12th century. After a walk in the old town centre we will transfer to another historical town Trebic. Overnight in Trebic.



DAY 6

After breakfast we will take a tour of the beautiful town of Trebic which many sights such as the Jewish Quarter and St. Procopius Basilica is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. After the tour of the city we will enjoy the free day or for the ones that wish we can go and visit the caves and national park Moravsky kras. Overnight in Trebic.



DAY 7

After breakfast we will depart to Slovakia and on our way visit Trencin and its castle on the massive rock which was the Northeast destination of Julius Cesar. The castle was an important residence of Matus Cak and was built in the 14th century. Later in the afternoon we will take an easy hiking tour of Janosikove diery, located in the natural protected area of Rozsutec. After an exciting day, enjoy the spa and jacuzzi in your hotel. Overnight stay in a traditional slovak cottage in Zazriva.



DAY 8

After breakfast we will start YOUR day with visits to Brusno-Chrenovec, Jalovec and Rastocno – all these villages are close together and also on the way to Cicmany and Bojnice. We will also visit our famous fairytale – Bojnice castle and a unique traditional slovak village Cicmany. Overnight in a traditional slovak cottage in Zazriva.



DAY 9

This day we will transfer to Vlkolinec where we will visit this unique UNESCO heritage site – its an original folk village hidden in the mountains, after that we'll have a traditional lunch at a sheep farm, where we will taste the original slovak meals, after lunch we will descend down into the ice cave in Demanovska valley, and then take a cable-car up to Lomnický peak, where you'll enjoy the scenery of the world-famous High Tatras mountain range. Overnight in the High Tatas at famous Strbske pleso– 4*hotel.



DAY 10

We will spend this day in the east of Slovakia and visit landmarks such as the UNESCO heritage – Spis castle - the biggest castle in Central Europe, UNESCO heritage towns – Levoca with a famous altar of Master Pavol and Bardejov/optional/. Overnight in the High Tatas at famous Strbske pleso– 4*hotel.



DAY 11

After breakfast we will transfer to Piestany – popular baths town and after a short visit of this city we will transfer to Pezinok to taste some of the best slovak wines with a tour of the winery. After an enjoyable tour will transfer to the slovak capital – Bratislava, where you'll tour this beautiful city by old train and see the landmarks such as the old theatre, Hviezdoslav square, Town hall, Bratislava castle and many other great places. After an enjoyable ride we will board a boat and take a relaxing ride to Vienna. Overnight in Vienna – 4*hotel.



DAY12

We will start with the tour of Vienna where we will take a walking-tour of Vienna's historic backbone, engaging with the relics of the Habsburg Empire's 640-year rule, with highlights including Stephansplatz, the Opera House, Hofburg, Parliament and the City Hall, stopping in the city-centre to savor every chocoholic's dream: Viennese Sacher Torte! Enjoy the evening at a classical Mozart concer. Overnight in Vienna – 4*hotel.



DAY 13

The day begins with a visit to the nearby Schonbrunn castle, its Baroque palace and gardens, having been in possession of the Habsburgs for centuries, remain largely in their original historical condition. After the visit to the castle free programe –departure to the airport.
